Proclaiming the Sovereign Majesty of God

Finally, it might be argued that Luke's interest is not so much in a theological idea as in a person, namely Jesus Himself. The point is a fair one, for the main theme of the Gospel is undoubtedly Jesus Himself. But our concern is with Luke's particular view of Jesus, and for Luke He is the Savior. Emphasis on the abstract noun "salvation" should not be allowed to obscure the fact that it is Jesus, as the giver of salvation, who is the central figure in the theology of Luke.
