

## Outline for January 22, 2012 (Luke 5:16-17) – “On one of those days”

**Introduction:** As we look back on this most infamous day (Roe vs Wade 1973) our hearts are sad and as a nation it is imperative that we turn to God in repentance and brokenness. ###### a. “He would withdraw” (5:16)

- (1) He must meet with God – popularity was a constant temptation
- (2) Lonely, desolate places produce men of God not famous people

###### b. “as He was teaching...” (5:17)

- (1) Preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God – declaring the good news
- (2) The refreshing reality of the gospel and the eternal consequences of sin

###### c. “Pharisees and teachers of the law” (5:17)

- (1) They were not there to learn but to confront
- (2) Their agenda was one of greed and power
- (3) Grace abounding – pride intensifying

###### d. “and the power of the Lord...” (5:17)

- (1) Grace abounding – *iaomai* – to heal and restore
  - Creating (Romans 4:17)
  - Regenerating (Romans 1:16, 5; 16:25-27)
  - Life giving and sustaining (I Corinthians 1:18, 24)
  - Resurrection power (Philippians 3:7)
- (2) God was mightily at work in Capernaum
